

Guide for Dressing in Renaissance Style

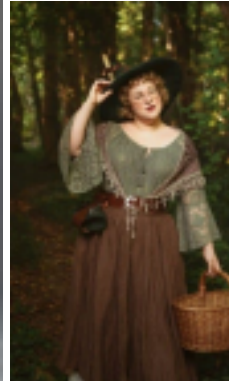
Below is a guide for the basics you will probably find in your own closet!

MEN:

- Top: Solid color top, worn loose (button-down or henley). Long sleeves should be pushed/rolled up to the elbow if that is comfortable to you. *Step it up: Linen. Vest.*
- Bottom: Solid colored pants (khakis, corduroy). *Step it up: Linen*
- Top and bottom can be monochromatic, or different colors.
- Brown or black belt over shirt
- Leather/dark shoes. *Step it up: Dark Boots*

Step it up with accessories!

- Hat (think flat-brimmed, pirate, Three Musketeers, a beret or ivy cap)
- Cloak or Cape (you can find these on Amazon or PartyCity.com)
- Chunky bracelet, watch, pendant. Satchel/pouch around waist/hanging from belt.



WOMEN:

- Top: Solid or floral/textured top, worn loose. *Step it up: Linen. Vest or corset over top.*
- Bottom: Solid colored skirt, past knees, or pants. *Step it up: Linen. Flowy.*
- Top and bottom can be monochromatic, or different colors.
- Dress: Solid color or minimal floral pattern, past knees. Have a sundress? Throw a white/tan shirt under it.
- Brown or black belt over dress/top.
- Leather/dark shoes. *Step it up: Dark Boots.*

Step it up with accessories!

- Cloak or Cape (you can find these on Amazon or PartyCity.com).
- Ribbon in hair. Hair pulled up halfway. Crown of flowers.
- Necklace. Satchel/pouch around waist/hanging from belt.
